- Be an alumnus of Lahainaluna High School.
- Continue as a full-time student in an accredited two- or four-year college or university beginning Fall 2024.
- Scholarship funds are to be applied only towards school expenses for the upcoming school year beginning Fall 2024-2025 and may not be applied to past costs.
- Unused scholarship awards shall be returned to Lahaina Restoration Foundation.
- Children, grandchildren, brothers or sisters of employees or board members of Lahaina Restoration Foundation are ineligible to apply for the LRF scholarship.
